



Nursery Fees 2025/26

All 3 to 4-year-olds can get 570 free hours per year. At Hollington Primary School Nursery we offer this as 15 hours a week for 38 weeks of the year. Parents working between the equivalent of 16 hours a week at Minimum Wage and less than £100,000 adjusted net income may also be eligible for 30 hours of funded childcare.

At Hollington Primary School Nursery, the 30 hours are offered Monday to Friday 9am to 12pm and 12.15pm to 3.15pm term time only. Subject to availability, parent's and carers' who are entitled to 15 hours but wish for their child to stay all day, can also pay for the additional hours charged at £5.10 per hour increasing to £6 per hour from September 2026. This is reviewed annually.

As a school-based nursery, we strongly believe daily attendance helps to ensure your child benefits from the full range of learning experiences and developmental opportunities, supporting consistent progress across all areas. When selecting a Full time or part-time place, please ensure your child will be able to attend each day.

Tax Free Childcare

Tax-Free Childcare is for working families, including those self-employed. You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).

How does it work?

For every £8 you pay into your online account, the government will pay in £2. This means you can get up to £2,000 per year for each child towards the cost of childcare (or up to £4,000 per year if your child is disabled). If you're eligible, you'll need to create an online childcare account via the [Government Tax-Free Childcare site](#). It should take about 20 minutes to set up, and you'll need your national insurance number to hand (if you're self-employed, you'll also need your unique taxpayer reference)
